Resolution No. 17, 2020

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING WILLIAM R. SHAW, HOCKING COUNTY ENGINEER, TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND/OR LOCAL CONTRACTS REQUIRED, AGREEING TO PAY THIRTY-THREE PERCENT (33%) OF THE COSTS OF SAID INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Ordinance No. 36, 2020

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 6, 2015, ORDINANCE NO. 6, 2014, ORDINANCE NO. 2, 2013, ORDINANCE NO. 25, 2009 AND ORDINANCE NO. 24, 2002 TO INCREASE THE HOURLY RATE OF PART-TIME FIREFIGHTERS.

**FIRST READING:**

Ordinance No. 37, 2020

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE TOTAL SUM OF \$4,400.00 FROM UNAPPROPRIATED MONEY IN THE GENERAL FUND. . These funds are to pay a lawsuit involving law enforcement that originated in 2015. The city began using body cameras as a result of this lawsuit, which would have been avoided if cameras had been in use at that time.

Ordinance No. 38, 2020

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A LINE ITEM WITHIN THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND AND APPROPRIATING FROM UNAPPROPRIATED MONEY IN THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND THE SUM OF \$10,000.00 TO THE NEWLY CREATED LINE ITEM AND TRANSFERRING THE TOTAL SUM OF \$51,211.00 FROM OTHER CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT LINE ITEMS TO THE NEWLY CREATED LINE ITEM.

Ordinance No. 39, 2020

AN ORDINANCE GIVING LOGAN PUBLIC TRANSIT THE AUTHORITY TO APPLY THE 2020 CITY LOCAL SHARE OF \$10,000.00 TO BE USED AS THE 2019 CITY LOCAL SHARE. The transit system used city funds in this manner last year as well.
